Mr. Connell presented to the board an estimate of \$75,000.00 to have the sweeper rebuilt, using the existing cab and chasse. The cost to replace the sweeper would be approximately \$250,000. The rebuilding will take 6-8 weeks.

Rescue Squad Captain Shaun Shannon was not present but his report was submitted. It was reported that there has been electrical problems in one of the ambulances and it is currently being repaired by Simmons Rockwell in Hallstead.

The Village Justice report was reviewed.
