Afsana Khundkar Richard Lowe was present to discuss the plans for 57 East Main Street The Lollipop Café.

Public Hearing was opened at 5:01 PM.

Chairman Kelia Dufton stated that the pink trailer that sells the food should be turned to face East Main Street and not Read Street. Officer Berry stated that the garage doors should be removed on the building and something nicer put on for the bay that is being converted.

The Board completed the Short Environmental Assessment Form and determined that the Lollipop Café will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts.

**A MOTION** was made by Officer Scoville, seconded by Officer Berry voted and carried to approve the the Short Environmental Assessment Form as a negative declaration with the conditions that the small pink trailer is to be moved back and turned to face East Main Street and the garage doors be replaced with a nicer looking alternative when that work is to be done.
