Local Law No 3 of 2023 Trap-Neuter-Return of the Town of Hancock was briefly discussed. The matter was tabled until the February Meeting when it could be discussed with Attorney McKertich who was unable to be present at this meeting.

An email from Kelly Nunn of Ricoh offering an updated lease agreement on the Police Department's current multi-purpose copy machine was presented. The monthly cost of a new machine would be less than what is currently being paid on a monthly basis due to the newer technology. The savings would be roughly \$50 per month. The monthly maintenance cost would not increase per Ms. Nunn.

**A MOTION** was made by Deputy Mayor Mead, seconded by Trustee Kuehn, voted and carried to be included in the Countywide Village-Initiated Shared Service Study, to be performed by Laberge Group at a cost of \$2,000.
