Some members of the rural fire district were present. The Board stated that everyone needs to work together to be able to obtain a new truck. Blaise Bojo stated he found a truck that was built for another fire department but would not fit in their fire house. The cost of the Truck would be around \$800,000 and they would need to purchase a new generator for it. New trucks that fits the needs of the fire department could be about \$1.5 - \$1.8 million dollars. All parties are going to do some figuring and number crunching and meet back on Thursday.
